- 40% Daily Assignments (homework/classwork/participation)
- 60% Assessments (Tests/Quizzes/Projects)

Google Classroom:

- All students are expected to join our class.
- There will be notes and assignments uploaded, along with videos. (Upload content will vary from unit to unit)
